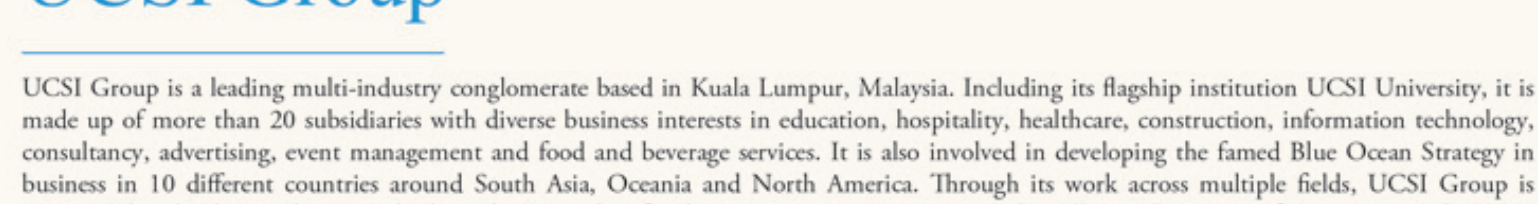

Leading a Government Initiative for Economic Growth

The UCSI University Hospital is part of a larger programme to lead a government initiative to help boost Malaysia's economy as part of its Economic Transformation Programme to become a high-income nation by 2020.
